Tax claim by the charity

The charity will reclaim 28 pence on every £1 you gave up to 5 April 2008. The charity can reclaim 25 pence on every £1 you gave on or after 6 April 2008. The Government will pay to the charity an additional 3 pence on every £1 you give between 6 April 2008 and 5 April 2011. This transitional relief for the charity does not affect your personal tax position. If you pay income tax at the higher rate you must include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self Assessment tax return if you want to receive the additional tax relief due to you.
